- **3.** You must prove you can read, write, speak and understand English by passing an approved test at a minimum level of B1 (IELTS equivalent 4-5) in each of the four areas to gain a Skilled Worker visa. More information and guidance will be provided during the application process.

You must be proactive with any requirements to apply for the visa, as submissions can take up to three weeks to be processed. All information needed for the application, will be provided to you during the selection process, as will any other guidance you require, right up to the point you arrive in the UK.

The course for Veterinary Meat Hygiene Inspector learning course takes 4 weeks.

You will be provided with a car, UK mobile phone and all other equipment required to excel in your new role.
